

Privacy Policy

European Safety Systems Limited ("We") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This notice explains what personal data (information) we hold about you, how we collect it, and how we use and may share information about you during your employment and after it ends. We are required to notify you of this information under data protection legislation. Please ensure that you read this notice (sometimes referred to as a 'privacy notice') and any other similar notice we may provide to you from time to time when we collect or process personal information about you.

Who collects the information

European Safety Systems Ltd trading as E2S Warning Signals ('Company') is a 'data controller' of Impress House, Mansell Road, Acton. London, UK, W3 7QH and gathers and uses certain information about you. This information is also used by our affiliated entities and group companies, namely European Circuit Solutions Ltd, E2S Warnsignaltechnik UG, E2S Group Ltd, Foxley Estates Ltd (our 'group companies') and so, in this notice, references to 'we' or 'us' mean the Company and our group companies.

This policy (together with our terms of use and any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Your rights

1. Customer Privacy Policy

What personal information do we collect?

We collect information about you when you request a quotation, send us a purchase order, request a credit account to be set up, when you make a complaint, or when you become our customer. We collect data such as your name, contact details and other relevant details.

How do we use your information?

Our lawful basis for processing your information under the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) is under the legitimate interest's principle.

We control and process your data to fulfil contractual obligations. We also use your data to ensure the prevention of fraud and dishonesty, and for the carrying out of analytics across our datasets.

In order to achieve this, we share data with third parties, debt recovery agencies, law enforcement agencies, professional advisors, and other relevant parties. Information we hold about you will be retained for no longer than 7 years after our final correspondence with you, except in order to meet legal, tax or accounting requirements.

If you are an existing customer, we may contact you with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale to you.

If you are a new customer we will contact you by electronic means only if you have consented to this.

Consent to send Marketing information

We need your consent to contact you for marketing purposes. We will contact you by email asking you to consent to us sending you marketing information. No marketing information will be sent to you without your prior consent. 2. Web site Privacy Policy

Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site www.e2s.com (our site). This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our site or any other use of our site.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our site and of the fulfilment of your orders.

IP addresses

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and other purposes. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

Cookies

For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on your browser or the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalised service. Some of the cookies we use are essential for the site to operate.

If you register with us or if you continue to use our site, you agree to our use of cookies.

Where we store your personal data

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. Such staff maybe engaged in, among other things, the fulfilment of your order, the processing of your payment details and the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Any payment transactions will be encrypted using SSL technology. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use or terms and conditions of supply and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of European safety Systems Limited, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.
